

## The Downside of Fertility

- Three Main Global Fertility Facts:
  - 1. The fertility decline is everywhere in the world today.
  - 2. Levels in most countries today are below replacement.
  - 3. The decline in fertility in many parts of the world is not new.
- Given Facts (1) and (2) there should be a common cause.
- Given Fact (3): Why are we talking about this issue now?
- The unifying factor is the increased agency of women and a mismatch between what women need to have children and what men are willing or able to promise. That is the "downside" of fertility.
- Two Examples of the Unifying Factor:
  - The United States post Baby Boom peak
  - The Role of the Macroeconomy in the Fertility Decline across Nations




Fig. 1. TFR, 1970-2022: 3 Group 1, 3 Group 2 Nations




Fig. 2. U.S. Total Fertility Rate, General Fertility Rate: 1908-2023




Fig. 3. Median Age at First Marriage: College Grad Women, All Women, U.S.




Fig. 4. Fraction Zero Births by Age 40+: U.S. Women, by Education and Cohort Year




Fig. 1. TFR, 1970-2022: 3 Group 1, 3 Group 2 Nations




Fig. 5. Total Fertility Rate: 1950-2022, Six Group 1 Nations




Fig. 6. Total Fertility Rate: 1950-2022, Six Group 2 Nations




Fig. 7. Log(GDP/capita) PPP: 1920-2022, Six Group 1 Nations




Fig. 8. Log(GDP/capita) PPP: 1920-2022, Six Group 2 Nations




Fig. 7. Log(GDP/capita), Group 1

Fig. 8. Log(GDP/capita), Group2





Fig. 9: TFR is Negatively Related to Gender Disparities in Household & Care Work
