Daniel Yergin is vice chairman of IHS Markit and founder of IHS CERA (formerly Cambridge Energy Research Associates), which now is part of IHS Markit. His areas of expertise include energy, international politics and economics.

In 1992, Mr. Yergin received the Pulitzer Prize for general nonfiction for his book "The Prize: The Epic Quest for Oil, Money, and Power." His awards include the Lifetime Achievement Award from the prime minister of India and the United States Energy Award for "lifelong achievements in energy and the promotion of international understanding."
