## RELEASE SCHEDULE FOR THE KANSAS CITY FED'S LABOR MARKET CONDITIONS INDICATORS

KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI – The Kansas City Fed's Labor Market Conditions Indicators (LMCI) are two monthly measures of labor market conditions based on 24 labor market variables. One indicator measures the level of activity in labor markets and the other indicator measures momentum in labor markets. The release schedule for 2023 is as follows.
