Envision a U.S. economy that works for everyone

Imagine an economy where racial and gender economic disparities in the labor market no longer exist. Would there be more shared prosperity for everyone? That's the question behind a new state gross domestic product (GDP) simulation from community development experts across the Federal Reserve System.

A team of Federal Reserve community development experts conducted a thought experiment to find out.
