**KANSAS CITY, MO.** – The Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City’s [presidential search committee](#) will host a virtual community town hall on Wednesday, July 13, to address questions and provide an update on its search for a successor to President and CEO Esther George, [who will be required to retire](#) in 2023.

Panelists will include the Kansas City Fed’s presidential search committee chair, [María Griego-Raby](#) and Kansas City Fed board chair [Edmond Johnson](#). Tim Todd, [executive writer](#) and historian, at the Kansas City Fed will moderate the discussion.
