Kansas City Fed to host virtual community town hall

The public is invited to discuss the next Kansas City Fed President

KANSAS CITY, MO. - The Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City's presidential search committee will host a virtual community town hall on Wednesday, July 13, to address questions and provide an update on its search for a successor to President and CEO Esther George, who will be required to retire in 2023.

Panelists will include the Kansas City Fed's presidential search committee chair, María Griego-Raby and Kansas City Fed board chair Edmond Johnson. Tim Todd, executive writer and historian, at the Kansas City Fed will moderate the discussion.

The event will be on July 13, at 5:15 p.m. CT. The public can now register and pre-submit questions here to attend the virtual event.
