About the CDAC

The **CDAC** is composed of community, banking and labor leaders from throughout the Tenth Federal Reserve District: Colorado, Kansas, western Missouri, Nebraska, northern New Mexico, Oklahoma and Wyoming. Council members serve a three-year term and are expected to attend two meetings per year, typically in the spring and fall. Travel expenses are reimbursed by the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City.

The Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City established the CDAC in 2001 to provide Bank leaders a deeper understanding of the community and economic development issues impacting low- and moderate-income communities. CDAC members provide feedback on the Bank's community development research, programs and resources. Council members also receive updates on the national and regional economies.
