Garry Clark, a native of Washington, D.C., received his Bachelor of Science in Sociology from Dana College, Blair, N.E. and his Master of Science in Urban Studies/ Public Administration from The University of Nebraska at Omaha. Clark started out as a City Planner /Main Street Manager Newberry, Florida (right outside of Gainesville, Florida). He worked as an Economic Development Specialist for the City of Bowie, Maryland, and as Main Street Executive Director in downtown D.C.

Clark currently runs the Cuming County Economic Development program in West Point, Nebraska. Clark focuses on all aspects of economic and community development for the communities of Bancroft, Beemer, West Point and Wisner. Although his Alma mater is no more, Clark was inducted into the Dana College Hall of Fame for Track and Field in fall of 2010. He holds 9 track and field records (most ever in the school's history) and was the first male National Champion for Dana College.
