



Traveling Trunk Reservations

The **Traveling Trunk** has been created for elementary and middle school students to develop an awareness of the Federal Reserve Bank and to share resources available to teachers on money and banking. The trunk includes hands-on artifacts with related talking points, as well as lesson plans and activities to teach money concepts. The trunk resources offer instruction in economics and personal finance, and include extension activities in math, reading and social studies areas.

Policies for Trunk Requests:

- The trunk resources are suggested for grades 3-8. Some materials may be appropriate for younger students or adapted for older students.
- Two weeks advance notice is required for the trunk to be reserved.
- The trunk will be reserved in your name as a representative of your school or organization for a two week time period.
- The trunk should be picked up and returned by the requesting school or organization if it is within a 25 mile radius of the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City's closest office.
- The trunk will be shipped outside the 25 mile radius via Fed Ex upon request. (Shipping takes 1-5 days and will be paid for by the Federal Reserve.)
