Professor and Cargill Endowed Chair of Energy Economics, Iowa State University

Bruce Babcock is professor of economics and Cargill Endowed Chair of Energy Economics at Iowa State University. Dr. Babcock is also the director of the Biobased Industry Center and the energy policy platform leader for Iowa NSF EPSCoR. Previously, he served as the director of the Center for Agricultural and Rural Development at Iowa State University.

Dr. Babcock's research interests include understanding agricultural commodity markets, the impacts of biofuels on U.S. and world agriculture, the development of innovative risk management strategies for farmers, and the analysis of agricultural and trade policies.

Originally from Southern California, Dr. Babcock received his B.S. in economics of resource use and his M.S. in agricultural economics from the University of California at Davis, and his Ph.D. in agricultural and resource economics from the University of California at Berkeley.
