FINANCIAL FABLES ACTIVITY 2



The birds in Thriftyville—Penny Pigeon, Rosa Robin, Carl Cardinal and Judge Blue Jay—want to save for bird supplies. Each bird wants to save for a different product.

Use the clues below to find out each bird's savings goal.

1. Penny has bedding made from soft fabric, but no place to put it.
2. Rosa already has a supply of birdseed and a new house.
3. Carl is tired of searching for food every day.
4. Judge Blue Jay likes to cool his feathers after a hot, sunny day.

Use the chart to help you narrow your choices until you find the correct goal for each bird. Read one clue at a time to eliminate choices that won't work for a bird. Make an "X" in each box that can't be a right choice, based on the clue. Make a \$ in the box you know is the right goal for each bird. Each row and column should have three "X"s and one \$. Good luck!
