Proposal to Revise the Uniform Interagency Consumer Compliance Rating System with  
Request for Public Comment

**To the Chief Executive Officer of Each Tenth District State Member Bank:**

The Federal Financial Institutions Examination Council (FFIEC) requests comment on a proposal to revise the Uniform Interagency Consumer Compliance Rating System. The revisions are designed to more fully align the rating system with the FFIEC Agencies' current risk-based, examination approaches. The proposed revisions do not set new or higher supervisory expectations for financial institutions and their adoption will represent no additional regulatory burden. Comments must be received on or before July 5, 2016.
