

Background and Legislation

Legislative Mandate (2012-2013)

- Created the Intergenerational Welfare Reform Commission: Workforce Services, Human Services, Health, USOE, Juvenile Court
- Required regular reports and a data tracking system
- Required collaboration of Commission member agencies

What is Intergenerational Poverty?

- Poverty in which two or more successive generations of a family continue in the cycle of poverty and government dependence.

Utah's Goal:

Reduce the number of Utah families in the cycle of poverty, improving their quality of life and helping them become economically stable.



- It is not continued to the next generation.






FAMILY FOCUSED CASE MANAGEMENT: A TWO GENERATION APPROACH TO SERVING FAMILIES

increase




Family-Centered Case Management: Next Generation Kids




NGK Adults Pursuing Education & Training




Employment Increases in NGK



Participation in Financial Coaching




Change in Wages from 2014 to 2015




Participation in Preschool




Public Health Insurance Enrollment
