LOOK LIKE A MILLION BUCKS AT THE MONEY MUSEUM

A new interactive exhibit at the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City's Money Museum lets visitors join the ranks of George Washington, Alexander Hamilton, Benjamin Franklin and others who appear on the nation's currency.

The 10-J Currency Design Studio helps visitors create their own customized currency with the use of interactive touch screens. Visitors can include a number of design elements in their currency, including graphics, colors and sayings. In addition, visitors have the option of having their digital photo taken to include on their one-of-a-kind design. Once complete, the studio can e-mail the currency to visitors in order to share with friends and family, print out at home or post on the Internet.

Admission and parking are free at the Money Museum, located at the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City, 1 Memorial Drive, near the Liberty Memorial. The Money Museum provides an in-depth and behind-the-scenes look at the operations of the Bank and its role in today's economy. Walk-in visitors with photo ID are welcome for self-guided tours from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, except for Bank holidays.
