**KANSAS CITY FED TO HOST FORUM FOR MINORITY BANKERS;**  
**Agenda includes sessions with Janet Yellen, Esther George and others**

The Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City is hosting a forum this month designed to provide minority bankers with industry knowledge and leadership development to enhance their careers and grow their professional networks. “Banking and the Economy: A Forum for Minority Bankers,” will be held September 28-29 at the Kansas City Fed’s headquarters, 1 Memorial Drive, in Kansas City, Mo.

The forum will feature insights from a number of leaders, including an opening dinner keynote address from Kansas City Fed President Esther George on Sept. 28 and a conversation with Federal Reserve Chair Janet Yellen, who is participating via videoconference on Sept. 29.
