KANSAS CITY FED TO HOST FORUM FOR MINORITY BANKERS

The Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City, in partnership with the Federal Reserve Board of Governors and the Federal Reserve Banks of Atlanta, Minneapolis, Philadelphia, Richmond and St. Louis, is hosting a second annual forum designed to provide minority bankers with industry knowledge and development to enhance their careers and grow their professional networks. “Banking and the Economy: A Forum for Minority Bankers,” will be held September 27-28 at the Kansas City Fed’s headquarters, 1 Memorial Drive, in Kansas City, Mo.
